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Brooch / Pendant. Hand painted miniature on porcelain, circa 1910-20. 9ct gold. Dimensions 53mm x 41mm. Signed Harry Tittensor.

Portrait identity unknown. [1].

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Pottery plaque with the profile head of a young woman with Grecian coiffure, wearing a pearl necklet against a laurel leaf ground in naturalistic colours. Signed with initials "H.T.", impressed factory mark, painted "FL 350" on reverse. Diameter 44cm [2].

Often attributed to Pinder & Bourne Co. (1862-1882) who were taken over by Doulton in 1882.

Could it be a later piece by Doulton painted by Harry Tittensor?

'Japanese Fan'. A bowl and cover designed by H. Tittensor, the cover decorated with seated Japanese figure holding a fan, painted in shades of yellow, green, black and purple on a pearl lustre ground, printed factory mark. [4].
